Student Eligibility and Requirements

- Eligible candidates must be a traditional (age 18-22) full time sophomore student enrolled in agricultural coursework.
- Candidates must possess a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- Applicants must have a permanent residence in Nebraska, Iowa, South Dakota, Kansas, or Wyoming.
- Preference is given to those who intend to return to the farm/ranch or a farm related job in a rural community.
- Financial need will not be a consideration.
- If selected as the recipient, an acceptance letter indicating the student's future would be appreciated.
- The scholarship amount is to be paid out as follows: \$1000 in fall 2023 semester and \$1000 paid in spring 2024 semester to each recipient.
